### CONFLICTS OF INTEREST IN THE DESIGNATED ASSESSMENT CENTRE (DAC) SELECTION PROCESS, AND REPORTING OBLIGATIONS FOR DACS ASSESSING TREATMENT PLANS

*Superintendent's Guideline No. 08/03*

*October 2003*

#### Introduction

This Guideline is issued pursuant to section 268.3 (1) of the *Insurance Act* for the purposes of O. Reg. 403/96, *Statutory Accident Benefits Schedule - Accidents on or After November 1, 1996* (SABS), amended to O. Reg. 380/03.

#### Assessor Conflict of Interest

Amendments to section 53 of the SABS became effective on October 1, 2003 and change the process for selecting a Designated Assessment Centre (DAC) by permitting the claimant and insurer to jointly select a DAC. If the parties are unable to select a DAC within the time frame set out in the SABS, or if the DAC selected cannot begin the assessment within the time frame set out in the SABS, the Superintendent of Financial Services will select a DAC.

This Guideline establishes the following process for identifying, disclosing and resolving a conflict of interest situation when the claimant and insurer are selecting a DAC:

- Insurers and claimants should, where possible, obtain and share information about any potential conflicts of interest before jointly selecting a DAC.
- Where the claimant and insurer have jointly selected a DAC, the SABS does not expressly direct a DAC to determine or disclose a conflict of interest. However, under the SABS, a DAC is in a conflict of interest if an assessor who is to conduct the assessment has previously assessed or treated the claimant.
- In order for a DAC to avoid a conflict of interest situation, and to ensure impartiality in the DAC system, a DAC must assign assessors to the case who are free of any conflict of interest, even in situations where the insured person and the insurer have jointly selected the DAC. A DAC that is unable to do so must declare the conflict before beginning the assessment. If the conflict is not waived, the insured person or the insurer may invoke SABS s. 53 (10) on the basis that the DAC is unable to begin the assessment, and ask for another DAC to be assigned by the Superintendent.

#### Assessment of Treatment Plans by DACs

Amendments to section 43 of the SABS became effective on October 1, 2003 and change the time frames in which DACs must report to parties.

Where the purpose of the DAC assessment is to determine whether an impairment comes within a *Pre-approved Framework (PAF) Guideline*, DACs are required to complete their assessments and report to parties within 5 business days (SABS subsection 43 (11)). If the assessment determines that the impairment does not come within a PAF Guideline, the DAC report must comment on whether the goods and services to be provided under the treatment plan are reasonable and necessary and include recommendations relating to the future provision of goods and services to the insured person (SABS subsection 43(9)).

This Guideline addresses DAC reporting requirements in situations where the insurer disputes a treatment plan on the ground that the impairment is one which should be covered under a PAF Guideline.

- *Insurer consents to treatment plan if DAC decides impairment does not come within a PAF Guideline.*

The OCF-11 Designated Assessment Centre Referral, Plan, and Summary Form has been revised to enable insurers to specify the exact nature of the dispute that is being sent to a DAC.

The insurer may indicate on the OCF-11 that the insurer will accept that the treatment plan as submitted is reasonable and necessary if the DAC determines that the impairment does not come within a PAF Guideline.

In this situation, if it does determine that the impairment does not come within a PAF Guideline, the DAC could state in its report that it concurs with the parties that the goods or services contemplated under the treatment plan are reasonable and necessary and recommends the provisions of the goods and services outlined in the treatment plan. This would satisfy the DAC's obligations under subsection 43 (9) of the SABS. The DAC would not have to do further investigations into the treatment plan in order to come to this conclusion.

- *Insurer disputes treatment plan*

The insurer may instead indicate on the OCF-11 that, in addition to taking the position that the impairment comes within a PAF Guideline, it also disputes whether the goods and services indicated in the treatment plan are reasonable and necessary.

In these situations, subsection 43 (9) of the SABS requires that the DAC's report state whether the goods or services contemplated in the treatment plan are reasonable and necessary and include recommendations relating to the future provision of goods and services to the insured person for his/her treatment and rehabilitation. This report must be delivered within 5 business days (subsection 43 (11)).

It is recognized that given this time frame, it may not always be possible for DAC assessments conducted under this provision to be as thorough or detailed as other treatment plan assessments, particularly in cases where the DAC determines that it must conduct a direct assessment of the insured person in order to make these recommendations. Nevertheless, the DAC's report must still address the matters referred to in subsection 43(9).

#### Introduction

Les présentes Lignes directrices sont émises en vertu de l'article 268.3 (1) de la Loi sur les assurances aux fins du Règl. de l'Ont. 403/96, Annexe sur les indemnités d'accident légales - accidents survenus le 1er novembre 1996 ou après ce jour, modifié par le Règl. de l'Ont. 380/03.

#### Évaluateurs en conflits d'intérêts

Les modifications à l'article 53 de l'AIAL sont entrées en vigueur le 1er octobre 2003 et modifient le processus de sélection d'un Centre d'évaluation désigné (CED) en permettant au demandeur et à l'assureur de choisir conjointement un CED. Si les parties sont incapables de choisir un CED dans les délais stipulés par l'AIAL, ou si le CED choisi ne peut entreprendre l'évaluation dans les délais stipulés par l'AIAL, le surintendant des services financiers choisira un CED.

Les présentes Lignes directrices établissent le processus suivant pour identifier, divulguer et résoudre une situation de conflit d'intérêts lorsque le demandeur et l'assureur choisissent un CED :

- Les assureurs et les demandeurs devraient, dans la mesure du possible, obtenir et partager les renseignements sur tout conflit d'intérêts possible avant de choisir conjointement un CED.
- Lorsque le demandeur et l'assureur ont choisi conjointement un CED, l'AIAL n'exige pas expressément que le CED détermine ou divulgue un conflit d'intérêts. Cependant, en vertu de l'AIAL, un CED est en conflit d'intérêts si un évaluateur qui doit effectuer l'évaluation a déjà évalué ou traité le demandeur.
- Afin que le CED évite toute situation de conflit d'intérêts, et afin d'assurer l'impartialité du système des CED, un CED doit nommer des évaluateurs qui sont libres de tout conflit d'intérêts, même dans les situations où la personne assurée et l'assureur ont choisi le CED conjointement. Un CED qui est incapable de le faire doit déclarer le conflit avant d'entreprendre l'évaluation. Si le conflit n'est pas résolu, la personne assurée ou l'assureur peut invoquer l'article 53 (10) de l'AIAL en vertu du fait que le CED est dans l'incapacité d'entreprendre l'évaluation, puis demander qu'un autre CED soit désigné par le surintendant.

#### Évaluation des programmes de traitement par les CED

Les modifications à l'article 43 de l'AIAL sont entrées en vigueur le 1er octobre 2003 et elles modifient les échéanciers auxquels sont soumis les rapports que les CED doivent présenter aux parties.

Dans les cas où l'évaluation des CED vise à déterminer si la déficience est visée par les Lignes directrices pré-autorisées, les CED doivent terminer les évaluations et présenter leurs rapports aux parties dans un délai de cinq jours ouvrables (paragraphe 43 (11) de l'AIAL). Si l'évaluation détermine que la déficience n'est pas visée par les Lignes directrices pré-autorisées, le rapport du CED doit préciser si les soins et les traitements à fournir selon le programme de traitement sont raisonnables et nécessaires et comprendre des recommandations sur la prestation ultérieure de soins et de traitements à la personne assurée (paragraphe 43(9) de l'AIAL).

Les présentes Lignes directrices traitent des exigences relatives à la présentation des rapports par les CED dans les cas où l'assureur conteste un programme de traitement en invoquant le fait que la déficience en cause ne doit pas être visée par les Lignes directrices pré-autorisées.

- L'assureur accepte le programme de traitement si le CED décide que la déficience n'est pas visée par les Lignes directrices pré-autorisées.

La formule FDIO-11, Aiguillage, plan et sommaire d'évaluation du Centre d'évaluation désigné, a été modifiée pour permettre aux assureurs de préciser la nature exacte du différend qui est soumis à un CED.

L'assureur peut indiquer sur la formule FDIO-11 que l'assureur reconnaîtra que le programme de traitement tel que présenté est raisonnable et nécessaire si le CED détermine que la déficience n'est pas visée par les Lignes directrices pré-autorisées.

Dans un tel cas, si le CED détermine que la déficience n'est pas visée par les Lignes directrices pré-autorisées, le CED peut indiquer dans son rapport qu'il confirme la position des parties selon laquelle les soins et les traitements envisagés en vertu du programme de traitement sont raisonnables et nécessaires et qu'il recommande que les soins et les traitements résumés dans le programme de traitement soient fournis. Ceci serait conforme aux obligations du CED en vertu de l'article 43 (9) de l'AIAL. Le CED ne serait pas tenu de faire d'autres vérifications du programme de soins afin d'en arriver à cette conclusion.

- L'assureur conteste le programme de soins

L'assureur peut cependant indiquer dans la formule FDIO-11 que, en plus d'adopter la position selon laquelle la déficience est visée par les Lignes directrices pré-autorisées, l'assureur conteste également le caractère raisonnable et nécessaire des soins et des traitements indiqués dans le programme de traitement.

Dans ces situations, l'article 43 (9) de l'AIAL exige que le rapport du CED indique si les soins et les traitements envisagés dans le programme de traitement sont raisonnables et nécessaires et comprennent des recommandations sur la prestation ultérieure de soins et de traitements à la personne assurée pour le traitement et la réhabilitation de celle-ci. Ce rapport doit être produit dans un délai de 5 jours ouvrables (paragraphe 43 (11)).

Il est reconnu qu'étant donné cet échéancier, les évaluations que les CED effectuent en vertu de cette disposition peuvent ne pas être toujours aussi complètes ou détaillées que les autres évaluations de programme de traitement, particulièrement dans les cas où le CED détermine qu'il doit effectuer une évaluation directe de la personne assurée afin de faire ces recommandations. Néanmoins, le rapport du CED doit quand même aborder les points mentionnés au paragraphe 43(9).

## INSURERS' DELIVERY OF DOCUMENTS TO INSURED PERSONS

*Superintendent's Guideline No. 09/03*

*October 2003*

### Introduction

This Guideline is issued pursuant to section 268.3(1) of the *Insurance Act* for the purposes of O. Reg. 403/96, the *Statutory Accident Benefits Schedule - Accidents on or After November 1, 1996* (SABS) as amended.

Amendments to section 68 of the SABS became effective on October 1, 2003 and include new requirements regarding delivery of documents. Where a document must be delivered within five or fewer business days to an insured person who is not represented and does not have a fax machine, section 68(2) of the SABS requires the insurer to personally deliver the document. Section 68(4) contains provisions for leaving the document with an adult at the insured person's residence if delivery directly to the insured person is not possible.

A health care provider<sup>1</sup> may, for the purpose of receiving certain documents from the insurer on behalf of the insured person, agree to act as the insured person's authorized representative for that limited purpose in the particular situations enumerated below.

### Process for health care provider to act as an insured person's authorized representative for purpose of receiving documents from an insurer

*The insurer may deliver a document to an insured person via a health care provider in the following circumstances:*

- Insured person is not already represented by a lawyer or other authorized representative<sup>2</sup>;
- Insured person's authorization is expressly limited to authorizing the health care provider to receive:
  - i. the insurer's written notice in response to:
    - (a) a Treatment Plan (OCF-18),
    - (b) an Application for Approval of an Assessment or Examination (OCF-22) or
    - (c) a Pre-approved Framework Treatment Confirmation Form (OCF-23/198), or,
  - ii. an insurer examination report under subsection 42(7) of the SABS;
- The health care provider agrees to act in accordance with the authorization;
- The signed authorization is provided to the insurance company prior to the insurer's delivery of the document referred to in the authorization; and
- The insurer relies on the authorization to deliver only such documents as are expressly referred to in the authorization.

*Health care provider's obligation upon receiving the document from the insurer:*

Upon receipt of the document from the insurer, the health care provider is obliged to immediately notify the insured person of the substance of the document by telephone and mail a copy of the document to the insured person by ordinary mail.

### Introduction

A health care provider should, before agreeing to act in accordance with such an authorization, confirm with the insured person that he or she is not already represented by a lawyer or other authorized representative.

<sup>2</sup>For the purposes of this Guideline, "other authorized representative" is a person named in Part 2 of the insured person's OCF-1, Application for Accident Benefits, to whom the insurer can deliver documents by fax under subsection 68(2)(a) of the SABS.

Les modifications à l'article 68 de l'AIAL sont entrées en vigueur le 1<sup>er</sup> octobre 2003 et comprennent de nouvelles exigences ayant trait à la livraison des documents. Lorsqu'un document doit être remis dans un délai maximal de cinq jours ouvrables à une personne assurée qui n'a pas de représentant et qui ne possède pas de télécopieur, l'article 68(2) de l'AIAL exige que l'assureur se charge personnellement de la remise du document. L'article 68(4) contient des dispositions concernant la remise du document à un adulte au domicile de la personne assurée s'il n'est pas possible de remettre le document en mains propres à la personne assurée.

Aux fins de la réception de certains documents de l'assureur au nom de la personne assurée, un fournisseur de soins de santé<sup>1</sup> peut accepter d'agir en qualité de représentant autorisé de la personne assurée, et ce uniquement à ces fins, dans les circonstances particulières énumérées ci-dessous.

**Procédure que les fournisseurs de soins de santé doivent suivre pour agir à titre de représentant autorisé d'une personne assurée afin de recevoir des documents d'un assureur**

*L'assureur peut livrer un document à une personne assurée par l'intermédiaire d'un fournisseur de soins de santé dans les circonstances suivantes :*

- La personne assurée n'est pas déjà représentée par un avocat ou par un autre représentant autorisé<sup>2</sup>;
- L'autorisation de la personne assurée est spécifiquement restreinte aux fins de l'autorisation du fournisseur de soins de santé à recevoir :
  - i. l'avis écrit de l'assureur en réponse à :
    - (a) un programme de traitement (FDIO-18),
    - (b) à une demande d'approbation pour une évaluation ou un examen (FDIO-22) ou
    - (c) à une formule de confirmation de traitement selon le cadre d'action pré-approuvé (FDIO-23/198), ou
  - ii. un rapport d'examen de l'assureur en vertu de l'article 42(7) de l'AIAL;
- Le fournisseur de soins de santé accepte d'agir conformément à l'autorisation;
- L'autorisation signée est fournie à l'assureur avant que celui-ci ne livre le document désigné dans l'autorisation; et
- L'assureur utilise l'autorisation pour remettre uniquement les documents qui sont spécifiquement désignés dans l'autorisation.
